

Serengeti Yacht Charter

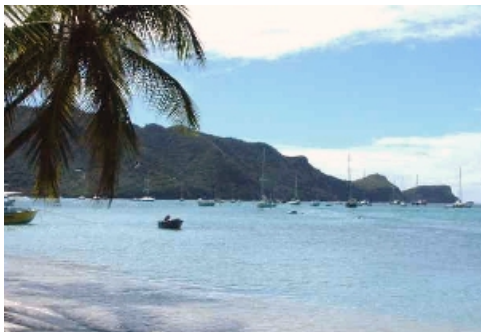
ONE WEEK IN THE GRENADINES CRUISE GUIDE

Day 1

Meet Serengeti in **Young Island Cut, St Vincent**, just a short hop from the airport. Spend the day relaxing on the boat and swimming and snorkelling in the turquoise waters or take the short climb up to historical Fort Duvernette and be rewarded by the stunning panoramic views. After sunset cocktails on the Serengeti, take a walk along the fairy-light illuminated shore, where you'll find a wonderful array of restaurants and bars.



Day 2



After a relaxing breakfast, take a short sail, south of the wind, to **Admiralty Bay, Bequia** – A favourite yachting haven. The beach is lined with a colourful array of small hotels, bars, restaurants and boutiques – so all kinds of entertainment are right at your doorstep. There are plenty of interesting places to explore inland, including the unique turtle sanctuary. There are also plenty of opportunities for

watersports.

Day 3

Sail along the south side of Bequia, passed the dramatic island of Petit Nevis, and arrive in **Mustique**. With miles of unspoilt beaches and countryside, this is a truly beautiful Island, popular with the rich and famous. Spend your day shopping at the elegant Treasure Boutique, or take a tour of the island by golf cart, motor bike or by horse! By sunset, you should find yourself seated comfortably, cocktail in hand, in one of the fashionable bars, such as Fire Fly, Basil's or the Cotton House. Take your evening from there!



Day 4



After a leisurely breakfast, take a short sail to **Charlestown Bay**, on the sleepy island of **Cancouan**. This is a delightful little island, which has only recently made itself accessible for yachts. Its one hotel is set in the prettiest of bays and provides all the entertainment you need, including great live music. After lunch, take a short sail to **Tobago Cays**. Indulge in the turquoise waters and enjoy what is really one of the of the top snorkelling spots in the world.

Day 5

Make a short stop in **Union Island**, before sailing on to **Carricou**. Carricou is a wonderfully unspoilt island, where you are unlikely to bump into any other tourists. Spend the day exploring some of the island's inland beauty spots, or simply sit back on the Serengeti and be served local fresh oysters and seafood. This island is a true hidden gem and cannot fail to delight!



Day 6



Take a morning sail down the lush, green west coast of Grenada and stop in **George Town, Grenada**. Stroll around the colourful streets that line the bay where you'll find a feast of fun shops and some wonderful local food. There a great places for water sports and several preety beaches close by.

Day 7

Sail to **Hog Island, Grenada**. This tranquil spot will provide the perfect setting for the final day of your cruise. Spend the day swimming, relaxing and sipping cocktails, while the crew prepare a Serengeti farewell feast! Arrangements will then be made to take you to the airport for your flight home.
